

Brave Holly says 'I do' on big day

A MUM-OF-SIX who was given just weeks to live after receiving a shocking cancer diagnosis was a beautiful bride as she tied the knot with her sweetheart.

Holly Blake, 34, married Nicolas Scott thanks to help from her family, local businesses and charity, Wedding Wish Makers who were able to plan the couple's special day and make sure everything was just right on the big day – as the couple took their vows in matching green Nike trainers.

The pair – now Mr and Mrs Scott – had planned an outdoor service but the poor weather conditions and flood warnings led to Leith's Duncan Place offering their venue at the very last minute.

After the ceremony, Holly and Scott made their way over to a Leith community gardens to spend time with their family and friends who have rallied around in support.

Langridge, set up a GoFundMe page with a target of £20,000 for bills, childcare and other financial support which has now been reached.

Crystal Bows Bridal Boutique on Great Junction Street were also able to help out by offering the bride a choice of four dresses after she struggled to find a tea length dress in a

size 24/26 which fit around the wheelchair she was using.

They said: "It was an absolute pleasure being able to help Holly find the perfect wedding dress. It was extremely important to her that the gown was T-Length and we managed to give her four gowns to pick from."

"Every girl deserves to feel like a princess for a day and

Holly is most certainly no exception.

"After seeing the wedding photos, she picked the perfect gown for her day and she looked absolutely beautiful. We are extremely honoured to have played a part in making her dreams come true."

Holly was diagnosed with a rare form of cancer called

Sarcoma which affects the body's connective tissue but her chemotherapy at Western General Hospital has been unsuccessful so far.

She had originally gone to hospital thinking with what she thought was a pulmonary embolism, a type of blood clot in the lungs after suffering from breathlessness and a persistent pain in

her right leg. However when she went to A&E two months ago, an X-ray showed that she had metastasised cancer.

Since then, doctors have found another lump and confirmed that the cancer has spread to other parts of the body with Holly now suffering from grade four sarcoma in her lungs and lymph nodes.
